

Sydney International Aquatic Centre—Painting Works



The Sydney International Aquatic Centre played a starring role in the 2000 Olympic Games, playing witness to many Australian gold medals. Due to the obvious access challenges, the structural steelwork above the pools had not been painted since construction. The surfaces showed signs of corrosion build up and coating failure.

Following a comprehensive submission that included details of humidity level testing and the impact on various types of paint, ProjectPlus were awarded the repaint project.

We had to think creatively to overcome the logistical challenges before us. They required the pool to maintain business as usual throughout the entire makeover.

All pool areas had to be carefully protected to ensure there was no impact from ProjectPlus's efforts in preparation and repainting.

Given the length of time since the initial paint and the high humidity environment, significant corrosion was present to the Aquatic Centre steelwork. ProjectPlus's preparation needed to be thorough and precise prior to the application of the epoxy coatings
